

He gained valuable experience at Ochre Architects and Ranjit John Architects, where he honed his skills across various architectural typologies. Drawing inspiration from local luminaries and international figures, Joshua integrates their philosophies into Yellow Door's work.

Central to Yellow Door's approach is the integration of natural light and consideration of site context and climate sensitivity. Joshua emphasises collaboration with clients and collaborators, blurring disciplinary boundaries to create cohesive spaces that enrich lives.
